**-22 October 1746**

**Princeton University chartered at the “College of New Jersey.”**



*Chartered in 1746 as the College of New Jersey, Princeton University was British North America's fourth college. Located in Elizabeth for one year and then in Newark for nine, the College of New Jersey moved to Princeton in 1756.*



*Today, more than 850 faculty members, who are leaders in their respective disciplines, instruct Princeton's 4,790 undergraduate students and 2,010 graduate students. Made famous by the movie “A Beautiful Mind” and recipient of the 1994 Nobel Prize in Economics, John Nash is currently a Senior Research Mathematician at Princeton.*
