


Today in Math History...

Saint Vincent de Paul Day. The devout Catholic, *Augustin Cauchy* was active in the Saint Vincent de Paul Society, Irish relief, and homes for unwed mothers.



Cauchy is known for his work with permutation groups, differential equations, determinants, probability, mathematical physics, wave propagation and optics, and fluid flow. He is best known for his work with the convergence and divergence of the infinite series and his work with the complex series.
