- B. Second line of four half-bands about 225 men each
- C. Two half-bands in reserve
- D. One band in double ranks filling intervals
- E. Detached half-bands to turn enemy flanks
- F. Half bands for flank security
- G. Place to which troops in intervals retire when enemy charge drives back first line
