The University of Leipzig is located in Leipzig in the Free State of Saxony Germany, is one of the oldest universities in Europe. Presently, it has grown to 14 faculties (colleges/departments), with over 29,000 students, and is Saxony's second-largest university. Since its inception the university has enjoyed almost 600 years of uninterrupted teaching and research. Arguably, the Faculty of Medicine is the university's most renowned faculty.
