ABSTRACT:

Over the course of the last six months, this team had the opportunity to support Tactical Ground Reporting Network (TiGR Net) fielding to line organizations. We captured notes on new technology fielding, organizational shifts to accommodate new capabilities and observed changes to collaboration. Our lab has spent the last few years supporting the development of TiGR Net, an interactive database that allows patrol leaders to catalogue information such as pictures, buildings, personnel, key events, mission reports, and other data into a system that will allow other soldiers to access the data.
