GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. See reverse side of this card for 1-Day/2-Day lesson sequence.

2. NOTE: "A" Saturdays are designated A/C for Commandant's Saturday or A/D for Dean's Saturday. The schedule is shown below. No advance lessons for courses are scheduled for Saturdays. During Dean's Saturdays (A/D), cadets may be required to attend examinations, lectures, films, seminars, makeup classes, additional instruction, counseling, or other authorized activities. If not scheduled to attend a mandatory activity, this time is reserved for individual study, class preparation, research, or laboratory exercises. On "B" Saturdays, the above activities may be offered, but cadets may choose to attend on Saturday or during alternate weekday offerings. On Commandant's Saturdays (A/C), the primary focus is on military program requirements. No academic requirements should be scheduled without the concurrence of O/Dean, ORD, and approval from O/Commandant.

3. The period following the noon meal on each 1-Day (Even Lesson) is designated as the Commandant's Hour. No activity may be scheduled during this period without approval of the S-3, USCC. The M Hour in this same period (Odd Lesson) is for 20 lessons of MS or other courses for cadets who cannot be scheduled in the A-L hours.

The period following the noon meal on each 2-Day is the Dean's Hour. For scheduling, the Dean's Hour may be combined with the K-hour to form a two-hour, fixed laboratory period, designated as the R, S, T, or U Lab Hours (see calendar on reverse side). Cadets enrolled in designated courses may be required to attend laboratory exercises during the Dean's Hour. If not scheduled to attend a laboratory, this time is reserved for individual study, class preparation, AI, research, counseling, compensatory time, makeup classes or other authorized academic activities. Fourth Class cadets may be scheduled for class or laboratory attendance in either the Dean's Hour or the K-Hour.

4. Cadets enrolled in MA100, MA103, MA104 and MA205 attend class in the designated time period both 1-Days and 2-Days. Normally, only four advance lessons will be scheduled each week, but the fifth attendance is reserved for scheduled academic activities. See administrative material issued by the Department of Mathematical Sciences for details.

5. Physical Education classes begin and end at times other than those shown above to provide time to shower and change uniforms. Refer to administrative instructions issued by the Department of Physical Education for proper reporting and departure times.

6. Cadets having more than one major graded requirement due the same day (more than two requirements for First and Second Class cadets) may request permission to attend an examination on an alternate day. Responsibility for seeking relief rests with the cadet, while the faculty role is one of cooperation in granting permission where reasonably feasible.
